

## Test of consciousness

During a discussion on the forums AstroClick few years ago, Gilles Lévesque whose nickname is glevésque (forums AstroClick) asked me if I could find an equation representing the conscience, reading the application for the first time, it seemed ridiculous to me, but without revealing my first impression, I even made a comment when I first got inspired by justice, I represent the case of a unconscious person who has little knowledge and a little ability to judge, I already had the basis for an equation of consciousness that is simply:

consciousness is proportional to the product of knowledge by the ability of judgment, which can be written as follows:

consciousness = (constant) (Knowledge) ('s judgment), Equation 1

Such an equation seemed to be an equation that I had already studied in thermodynamics and represents the volume of a mole of gas, this equation here:

volume of a mole of gas = [(molar gas constant) / (pressure)] (temperature), Equation 2,

comparing Equation 1 and Equation 2, so we can compare the consciousness with a volume or space, should that knowledge varies as the inverse of the social pressure to get training, which seems true, as should the temperature is proportional to the kinetic energy of gas molecules, so the electromagnetic waves received or has a comparable ability of a person because of his sound judgment they say light, which seems also comparable.

Now it remains to find the constant and to estimate the knowledge and ability to judge; capacity for judgment is not really intelligence, but consider anyway IQ or intelligence quotient as an indication of ability to judge,

for the indication of knowledge, I make a rough estimate as follows:

Quebec during the period of my studies, he was 7 years of primary school, 5 years of secondary school, 2 or 3 years of CEGEP (Collegiate), 3 or 4 years for first cycle, (graduate or diploma), 2 years for the second cycle (masters), 5 years for the third cycle (doctorate).

I give the number 2 for the primary and the secondary figure 2,

I give the number 1 for each year of College and figure 2 for each year of university,

considering a young Quebecers in 2013 has 2 years of CEGEP training as average, even if it is more or less true, it is only to give an example, with an average IQ of 100, if you want a conscience average of 100, must be constant equal to (1/6), as the total knowledge is expressed by the following sum:

$$2 \text{ (for primary)} + 2 \text{ (secondary)} + 2(\text{CEGEP}) = 6$$

the equation of consciousness is:

consciousness = (1/6) (Knowledge) ('s judgment), equation 3a

then replacing the ability to judge by the IQ is obtained 3b equation:

consciousness = (1/6) (Knowledge) (IQ), 3b equation

a normal person with a normal life experience has a normal consciousness, give the example of a person who has obtained a degree from a university,

without doctors are geniuses (with an IQ of at least 150) i have considered an IQ of 140 to give an example, their knowledge reached a figure of 26 ( 2pri. + 2se. + 2 Ce. + 6 u1 + 4u2 + 10u3), 3b equation gives:

$$\text{consciousness} = (1/6) (26) (140) = 606.67,$$

compared to a normal person who has a conscience 100, a doctor would have a conscience about 6 times more to raise a normal person, or  $(606.67) / (100) = \text{about } 6$ .

The experience of life also contributes to the acquisition of knowledge and experience of working life can improve the ability of judgment, experience a very active life can reverse the decline of knowledge and capacity for judgment finally all you can evaluate your conscience, I have given examples to guide you.
